AHCCCS/Medicaid.

Serves: Pregnant women, children, people with disabilities and those who can't afford to buy insurance on their own.

We have been serving members in Medicaid and CHIP managed care for more than 30 years. We employ a large and diverse workforce all across the state. Because we're part of the community, we have a genuine understanding of the challenges facing those we serve. We work with community organizations to overcome geographic, educational and cultural barriers to help improve access to care.

Children's Rehabilitative Services (CRS) Serves: Children with specified chronic and/or disabling health conditions, like cerebral palsy or cystic fibrosis.

Today, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan serves more than half of the state's special needs population, and we are the sole statewide contractor for Children's Rehabilitative Services. Members receive care through one of four Multispecialty Interdisciplinary Clinics (MSIC) located in Phoenix, Tucson, Flagstaff and Yuma. The CRS program is divided into four coverage types offering a combination of primary care and behavioral health services for members. All CRS members get specialty care for their CRS-related condition.

Developmentally Disabled (DD). Serves: People with developmental disabilities such as autism, epilepsy, cerebral palsy or a cognitive disability.

Since 1988, we have offered statewide service to individuals with developmental and cognitive disabilities like autism, epilepsy and cerebral palsy. Our clinical programs are designed to help strengthen the family's role as a primary caregiver, prevent inappropriate out-of-home placement, maintain family unity and reunite families who have been placed out of the home by providing a broad range of integrated support services.

Dual SNP. UnitedHealthcare[®] Dual Complete[™] (HMO SNP).

Serves: People who are aged, blind, disabled, or have a developmental disability.

UnitedHealthcare Dual Complete is for Medicaid members who have Medicare Parts A & B. This Special Needs Plan (SNP) offers more benefits than Original Medicare, such as credits for a health products catalog, glasses or contacts and dental coverage. Currently, we serve nearly half of the dual Medicare-Medicaid population in 14 of Arizona's 15 counties.

Available in: Apache, Cochise, Coconino, Graham, Greenlee, La Paz, Maricopa, Mohave, Navajo, Pima, Pinal, Santa Cruz, Yavapai and Yuma counties.

UnitedHealthcare Dual Complete One is for Medicaid members who have Medicare Parts A & B and are enrolled in our Long Term Care program. This special needs plan provides our Long Term Care dual eligible beneficiaries access to Medicare and Medicaid benefits under a single Managed Care Organization. We are able to coordinate the delivery of covered Medicare and Medicaid health and long-term care services, using aligned care management and specialty care network methods for high-risk beneficiaries. This plan is offered in the 10 Arizona counties where our Long Term Care plan is offered.

Dual SNP for LTC. UnitedHealthcare[®] Dual Complete[™] One (HMO SNP).

Serves: People who qualify for AHCCCS/ Medicaid and Medicare Parts A & B.

Available in: Apache, Coconino, La Paz, Maricopa, Mohave, Navajo, Pima, Santa Cruz, Yavapai and Yuma counties.



Long Term Care (LTC).

Serves: People who qualify for Long Term Care and Medicare Parts A & B.

Our Long Term Care Plan is for people of all ages who have a long-term disability due to age, illness or injury. We are able to offer services in a community setting instead of nursing home placement when possible. Case Managers assist our members with accessing care from their doctors, oversee the delivery of care, and add or adjust services when our members' needs change. In addition to improving health outcomes, we offer multiple member empowerment programs.

Dr. Health E. Hound[®] Fitness Challenge.



Under the direction of our own canine medical mascot, this program encourages school children to make exercise a part of their everyday lives. Children learn why physical activity is important for good health, and they learn fun exercises that are based on the President's Physical Fitness Challenge. Each child gets a free exercise journal to keep track of workouts at home. They also learn about Body Mass Index (BMI) as a measure of healthy weight and progress.

Innovations designed to make a difference.

In every program, and across the full continuum of care, we have worked to introduce innovations, improve service and reduce costs.



Improving health with telehealth technologies.

Many children throughout Arizona have special needs that require them to see specialist physicians

frequently. We employ two-way video conferencing to help enable orthopedic, craniofacial, neurosurgery and other specialists to treat these members from afar, which dramatically improves access to care for people in remote rural locations.

Accountable Care Communities.

Within our Arizona Accountable Care Communities, we have partnerships with 30 hospitals and 19 physical health clinic sites, caring for more than 145,000 members. Our model calls for a registered nurse to be placed in each medical practice. The nurse reviews daily reports showing members who have either visited the ER or are being released from hospital. The nurse then notifies the relevant primary care physician of the need to educate the member or provide follow-up care. This process was recognized by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) as a best practice to help reduce inappropriate ER visits and help lower hospital readmissions.



Advocate4Me.

Advocate4Me is a customer care approach that provides UnitedHealthcare's members with a single point of contact to address their various health needs. By calling a single toll-free number, or using their preferred communication channel, members are connected with an Advocate who provides them with end-to-end support, "owning" their request until it's resolved. This approach results in a simpler, more personalized and informed experience for the member.



Health4Me[™].

Health4Me is a free mobile app that provides UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members 24/7 access to a registered nurse, enables them to locate a nearby in-network physician, hospital or other

medical facility, and gives them access to their personal health benefits information.
